

The music tour is non-refundable even in the event that there is a state or national shutdown, all monies that were paid are non-refundable.

We encourage all families to invest in travel insurance and to purchase an additional insurance called, "cancel for any reason." The cost for insurance ranges from \$100-up, depending on when the insurance is purchased. If you purchase the additional insurance called, "cancel for any reason" that insurance needs to be paid within 14 days of your first installment, which would be the September 27, 2023, payment. Here are some suggested travel insurance companies that other music families have used in the past. October 10, 2023, will be the last day of purchasing the cancel for any reason coverage.

Travel insurances: Faye, AAA, AIG Travel Guard, and Travel Safe.

Travel Defender and Squaremouth are sites that will pull up different travel insurance companies to compare coverage and cost.

We do recommend that you contact the company personally and ask questions.

Here are some questions to ask:

- 1. Cancel for any reason policy will that cover a state or national shutdown?
- 2. Cancel for any reason what percentage is refundable? 50%, 75%, 100%?
- 3. If my child is unable to attend to due, medical, or disciplinary action with the school will they be covered under cancel for any reason?
- 4. What does the insurance cover?

Cancel for any reason

You're eligible for this add-on if you purchase it within 14 days of your initial trip deposit.

On what date did you make the initial payment towards this trip, such as your flight or hotel purchase?
